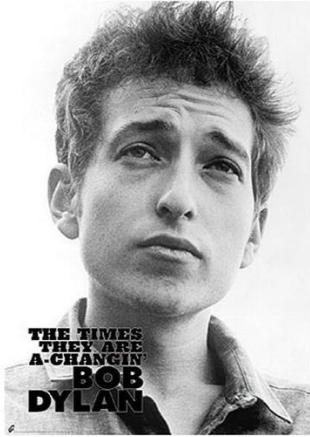


What can Bob Dylan tell us about the Civil Rights Movement?
